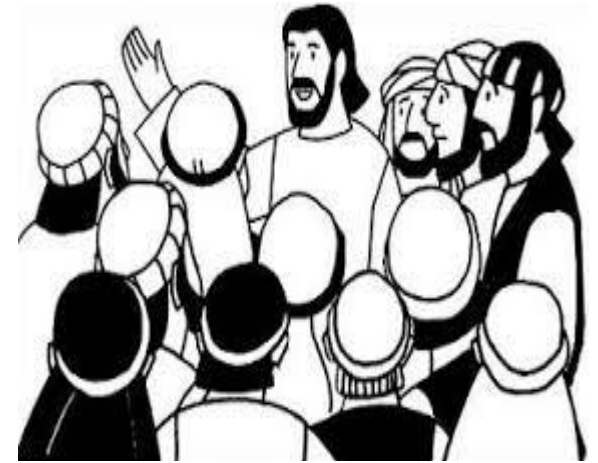
Please join us for coffee and fellowship in Johnston Hall following the service.

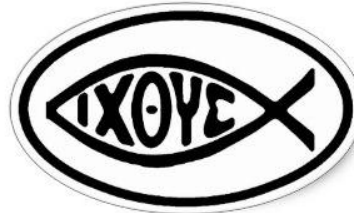
