in Alberton Church !

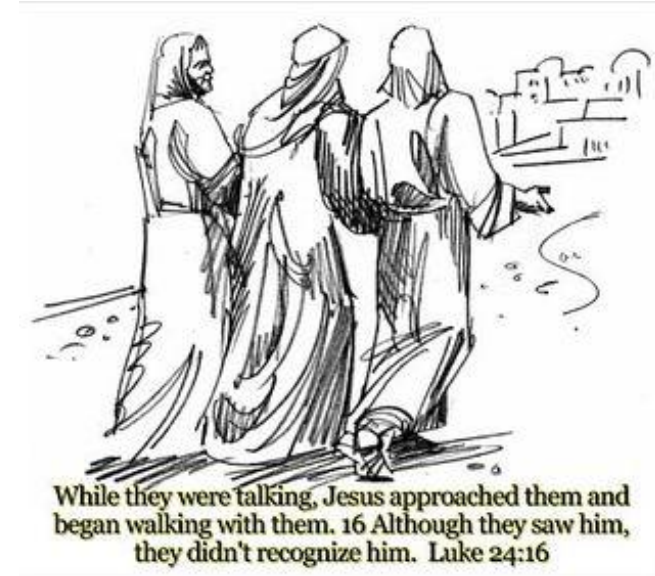
