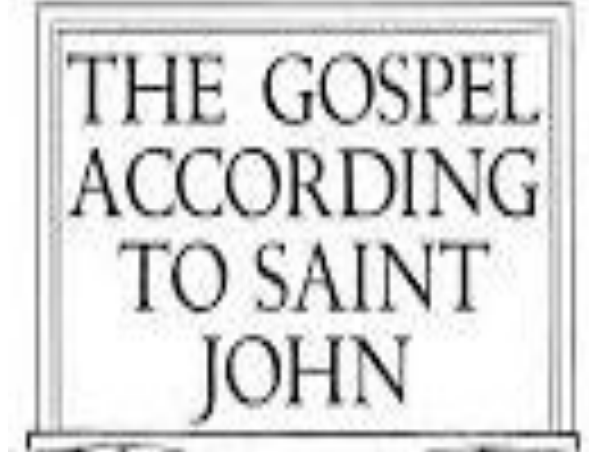

On February 17 and 24, we will focus on the crucial story of the beginnings of the Christian Church as recounted in the Acts of the Apostles.
