# Coming in Worship

On February 17 and 24, we will focus on the crucial story of the beginnings of the Christian Church as recounted in the Acts of the Apostles.

The two sermons on Acts will be entitled "A Handbook for life in the Church" and "Taking the Message to the World."

It has been confirmed this week that Dr. Bob will be having another round of eye surgery on Feb. 26th. #### Lenten Sermon Series
